The loan period is 30 days.

The borrower is responsible for two-way shipping on borrowed items. Please do not loan your material to anyone else because the material is checked out to you and you are responsible for its return. Please check the front of the package that you received, note the amount of postage that was required to get the package to you, and reimburse the librarian that amount in this envelope with your return shipment. A return-shipping label for the librarian is in this envelope. Shipping is paid by the librarian until you reimburse, not the club. Please make your check out to Tony Cable. An additional library request form is enclosed for your convenience.

If the material that you have is commercially produced, that is, in a "factory" slipcase, it must be replaced at current prices if it gets lost in the mail. Insurance is highly recommended. Check the labels on the front of the shipping container. If it was insured coming to you, it would be a good idea to insure it coming back to the librarian. A new copy of the material will cost you a great deal more than the couple of bucks spent on insurance.
